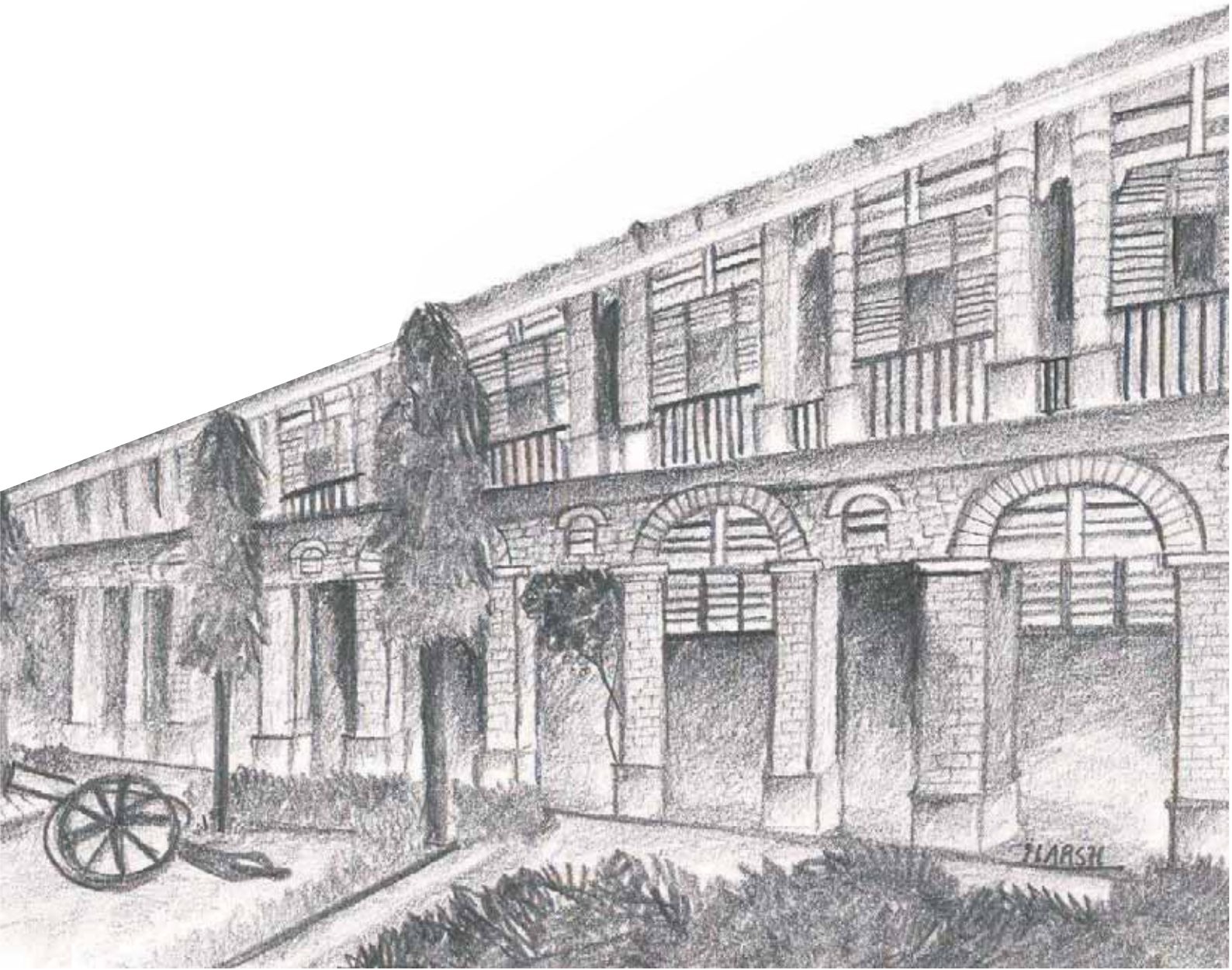
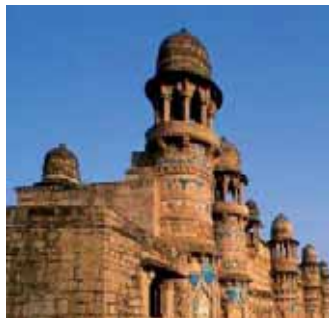




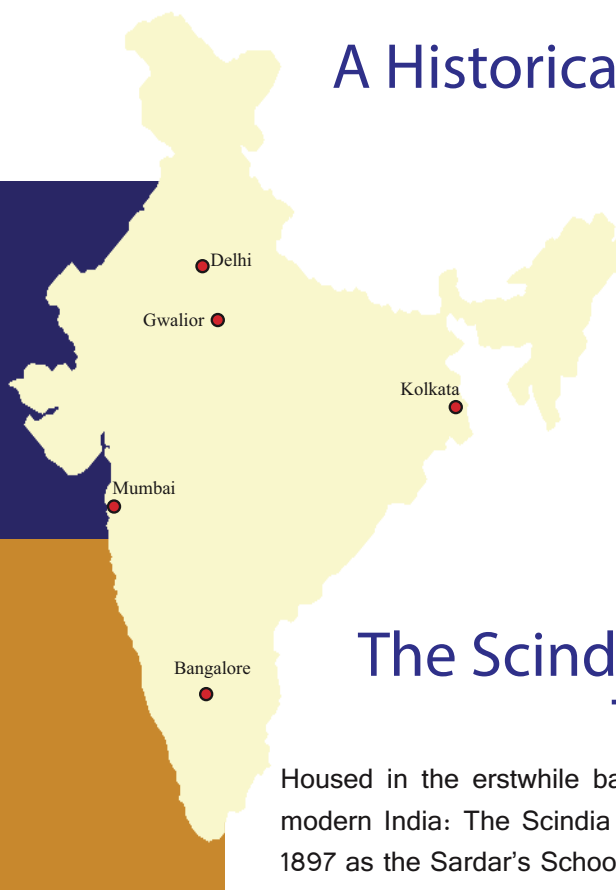

The Scindia School The Journey since 1897...

Housed in the erstwhile barracks of the British soldiers is Gwalior's unique gift to modern India: The Scindia School. This residential school for boys was founded in 1897 as the Sardar's School by the late His Highness Maharaja Madhavrao Jayajirao Scindia of Gwalior.

In 1933, the School was rechristened as The Scindia School. Based on the public school paradigm, it then started drawing students from all sections of society, placing well-rounded education within the reach of all – from the humble to the elite.

Today the school has the cachet of being one of the finest public schools in India, and it provides an all embracing, holistic education, with the desideratum of all round development of its students.

Standing on a steep mass of sandstone, the Gwalior Fort dominates the city and is its most magnificent monument. The school is located within the walls of the Fort and this distinctive location gives the school an exemplary ambience. It is arguably the only one in the world situated on a Fort with a unique ecology of its own.

His Highness Maharaja Jyotiraditya M Scindia, Member of Parliament, is currently the President of the Board of Governors and continues to reinforce the Scindia family's long association and commitment to the School.



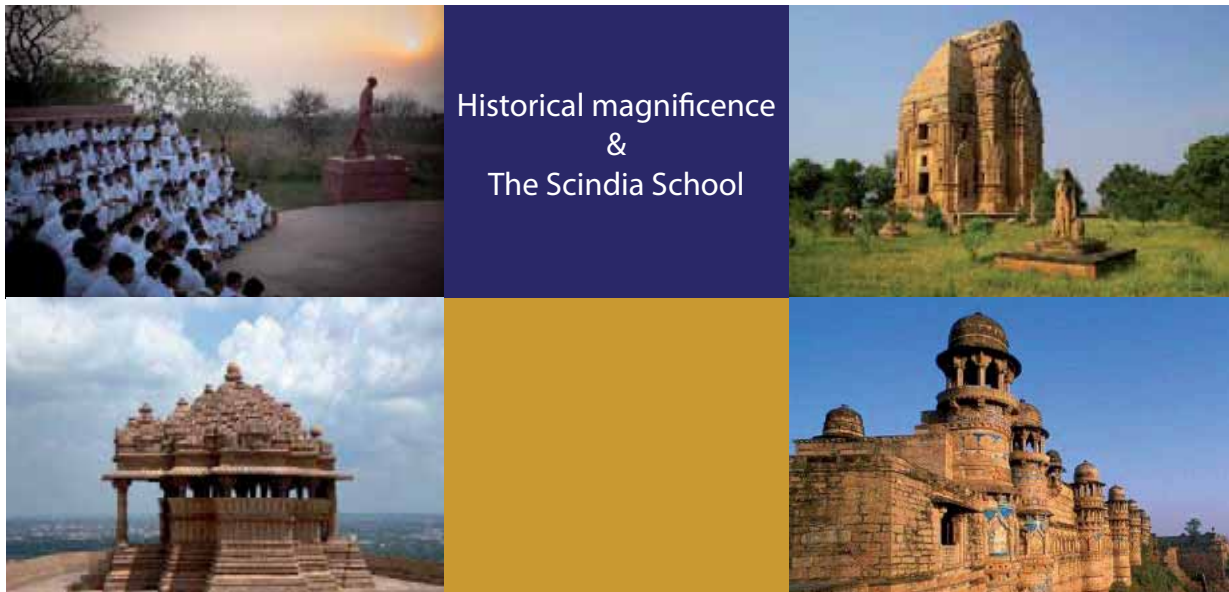

Values of a Scindian

The Campus

The Scindia School is set within the splendour of one of India's largest forts – the Gwalior Fort. With a strength of over 550 students, it has an extensive estate spread of about 160 acres.

History comes alive on the School's campus with several rare artifacts, statues and monuments dating as far back as the 9 century A.D. The Scindia School is a fine example of the amalgamation of historical magnificence and modern infrastructure.

The Scindia School offers a wide spectrum of facilities

for the overall development of students. These include a Science Centre; a well-equipped library; an open air theatre with a seating capacity of 3000 persons; a state-of-the-art dining facility with a seating capacity of 800 persons; a swimming pool; 21 playing fields and a Horse Riding Club.

A well-equipped infirmary with dedicated staff and basic services is available in the School. Should students require additional medical attention, they are attended to by specialists from the city.

Memberships

The Scindia School is a member of Round Square International – a worldwide association of schools, which strives to inculcate contemporary global values in the young.

The Scindia School is one of the founder members of the Indian Public Schools' Conference (IPSC) under which boys are sent to other IPSC member schools in India to participate in sports, debates, quizzes and other events. The School also hosts an IPSC event every year.

The School is also a member of the International Boys' Schools Coalition (IBSC) which is a non-profit organization of schools dedicated to the education and development of boys worldwide, the professional growth of those who work with them, and the advocacy and advancement of institutions – primarily schools for boys that serve them.

Career Counselling

The School has a robust Career Counselling Cell which creates awareness amongst students so that they are in a position to make informed choices. It is aided by a firm that conducts counselling, aptitude tests, personality assessment for students of Class X and another firm which provides guidance, updates and admissions' counselling for Indian Universities for students of Class XI and XII. It guides students throughout the school to help them focus on the right kind of skills, readings and exposure that would help them build their profile for admissions to various universities as well as for their careers.



Unique Aspects

Indian Ethos

The Scindia School provides a stimulating environment, encouraging students to inculcate an appreciation for Indian culture and values. Secularism and respect for diverse cultures are our core values.



Astachal

The School has institutionalized introspection amongst the students, through Astachal (Sunset Hill), a unique practice held each evening at the School, since its inception. Students observe silence for a few minutes aimed at encouraging self-reflection for greater self-awareness.



Social & Community Service

The School encourages students to participate in community welfare programmes in order to help develop the finer sensibilities of the boys. Such initiatives include: The Social Service League (SSL) promotes welfare programmes for physically challenged children and orphans. School has adopted the 'Sonsa' and 'Nathon-ka-Pura' villages for community development & welfare programmes. Boys have been actively involved in women empowerment initiatives in these villages. They assist in teaching them vocational skills. Other initiatives include Community Service Camps where boys undertake development work like construction of community centres, school buildings and toilets in these villages. The students and faculty are also sponsoring the education of several girls through the NGO - Nanhi Kali.



Academic Organisation

Admission

We offer admission in Classes VI, VII, VIII and IX and admission in Class XI is against vacancies. Assessment for admission to Classes VI, VII, VIII and IX is conducted twice, first time in November and the second time in January end. Assessment in November is conducted in English, Mathematics and Hindi and Assessment in January is organized in English, Mathematics and General Awareness. Both the assessments are organized in several cities of the country and abroad through Indian Embassies / High Commissions.

School Term

The academic year is divided into two terms interspersed with summer and winter holidays.

Curriculum

The School offers education from VI to the XII. A student is prepared for the Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), accepted by all Indian universities, which entails twelve years of school education prior to admission to a college. An indigenously designed curriculum is followed at the middle school level to maximize learning outcomes. A wide range of subject combinations is offered at the +2 level to suit the inherent aptitude of the student.



Information Technology – A Paradigm Shift

The Scindia School is a leading name in the ICT enabled schools of the country. We have the unique distinction of being the first school in the country to include IT in its curriculum. The first four boys who appeared for the CBSE Class XII exams in Computer Science were from The Scindia School. The Scindia School is also the first school in Asia to have an on-campus agreement with Microsoft. We justifiably boast of a contemporary data centre with almost 300 desktops. All the machines available for students and teachers in various labs and resource centers have the latest Microsoft solutions like windows 10 Pro, MS-Office 2016 and Adobe CS etc. Our Academic Block is equipped with smart classrooms which are used extensively for the purpose of instruction. Wi-Fi facility has been made available in the Senior Houses, Main Academic Block and the Modi Science Block. Netbooks have been provided to students of Classes IX-XII for academic purposes.

Student Exchange Programmes

The Scindia School enables its students to experience a truly global education and develop a greater understanding of other cultures by providing them opportunities to be a part of Student Exchange Programmes. The School is associated with many schools and colleges in the world.



The Round Square Conferences and Service Projects

Students and teachers participate in several regional and international conferences hosted by member schools. Students and teachers also participate in Round Square International Service Projects and expeditions around the world.



Educational Excursions

Educational excursions are planned on a regular basis to provide enriching and wholesome academic and cultural experiences to the students.



Pastoral Care

Each boy grows up in a warm and caring environment of a 'home away from home'. The School has twelve houses with approximately 50 students in each House. Each House has a pastoral team comprising the Housemaster, Resident tutor, Attached tutor and a Matron. The School's faculty is entirely residential, enabling a secure environment which provides for a feeling of family and community. A teacher-student ratio of 1: 10 enables personalized attention to each student.



Unique Aspects

Co-curricular Activities

Active engagement in various co-curricular activities promotes wholesome education which leads to the development of a complete personality.

Adventure

Educational and nature camps, mountaineering expeditions, trekking, white water rafting, cycling and skiing trips allow students to discover themselves. The students who successfully complete these activities earn their Bronze/ Silver/ Gold awards under the aegis of the International Award for Young People.

Clubs and Societies

More than twenty Clubs and Societies bring boys with common interests together, allowing them to express their creativity through multifaceted activities.



Sports

We have 21 sports' fields, 16 disciplines and 18 coaches for our students to develop and hone their inherent sporting talents.

School Council

Sharing a common platform with their Housemasters and the Principal, the boys contribute in making responsible and collective decisions for the benefit of the school community.

Scholarships

At The Scindia School academic excellence is valued and respected. The School provides scholarships to meritorious students.



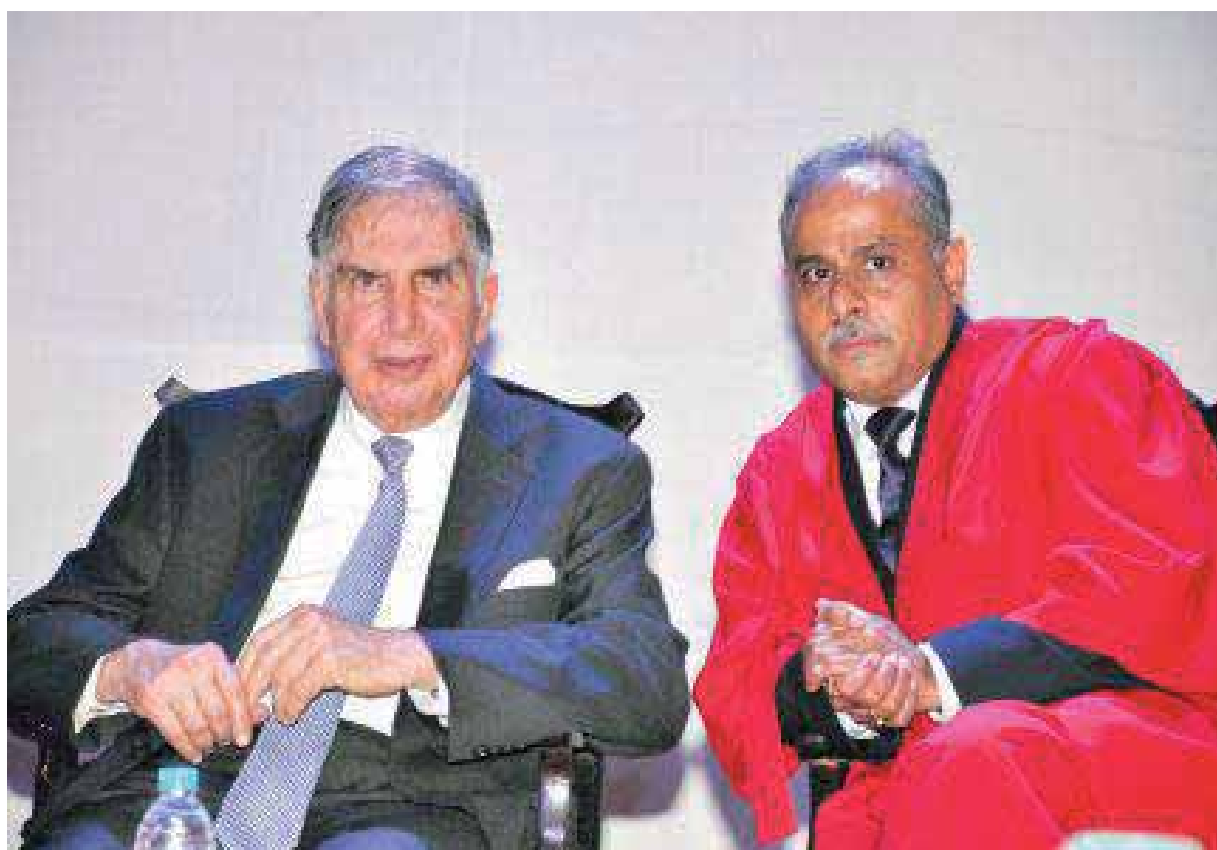
The Scindia Old Boys' Association

We have received Aqua Excellence Award 2016 for preserving heritage of the Fort; we have been awarded the 'Best Brand School' by Economic Times; we are ranked the 4th best All Boys' Boarding School in India and the first in Madhya Pradesh by Education World and we have recently been recognised as a 'Global League Institution 2017 – 18' based on the Student Satisfaction Survey conducted by 'Great Place to Study Research Institute'.

In the field of ICT our felicitations include the President's award for the Best IT Infrastructure at the state level in 2004 and the best ICT enabled school in India by e-India in 2009. A study of 31 schools from India and abroad through an independent agency 'Grand Thornton', rated The Scindia School as leading in 40 out of a total of 43 criteria.



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
