For Girls (LKG to VIII)

Same as summer uniform with following additions : Navy blue tie with light blue stripe. Navy blue V-necked Cardigan with light blue stripes around neck and hands, full sleeve blouse.

For Girls (IX to XII)

Navy blue tie with light blue stripe, Navy blue blazer with logo. Light blue skirt.
