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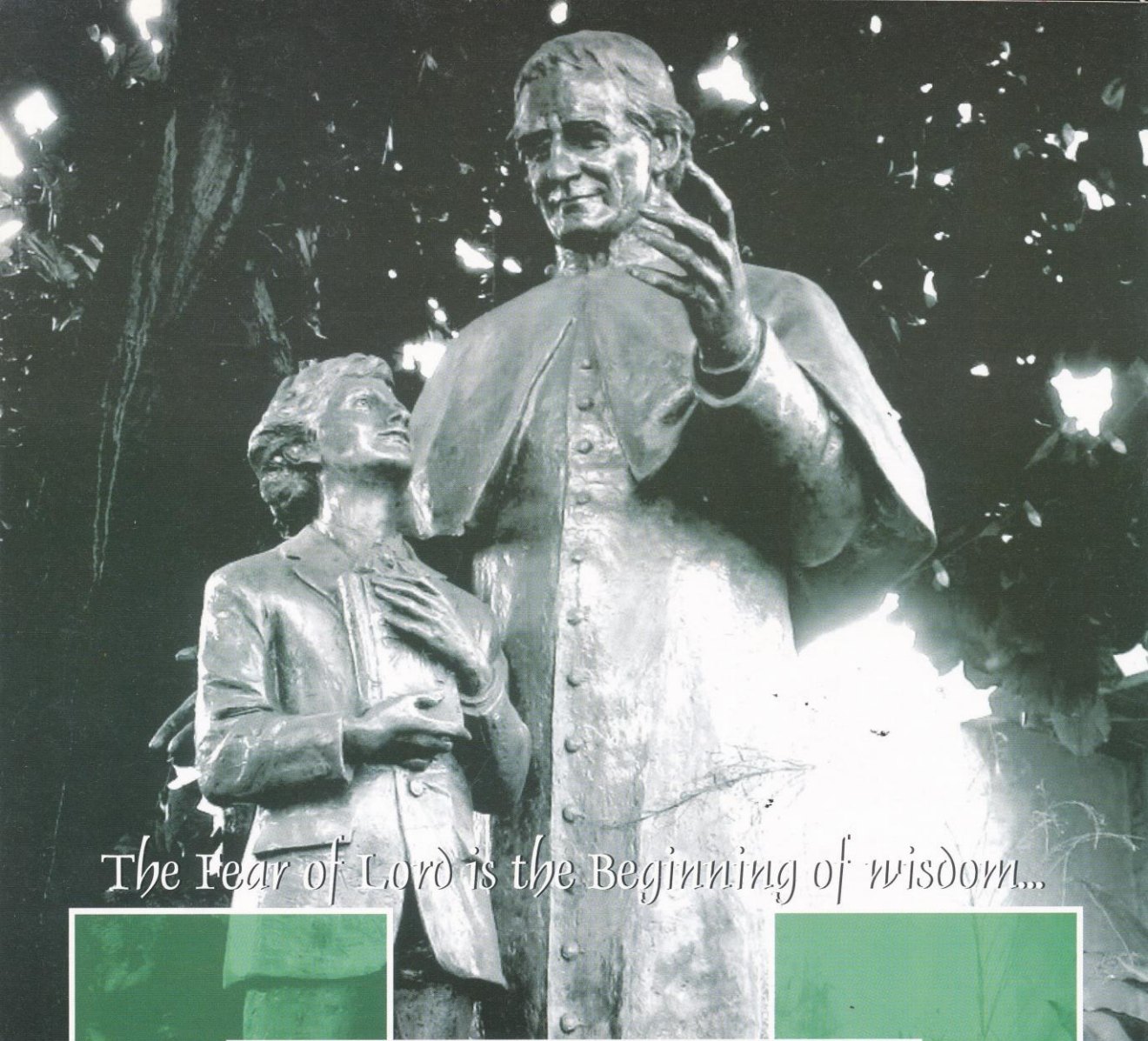
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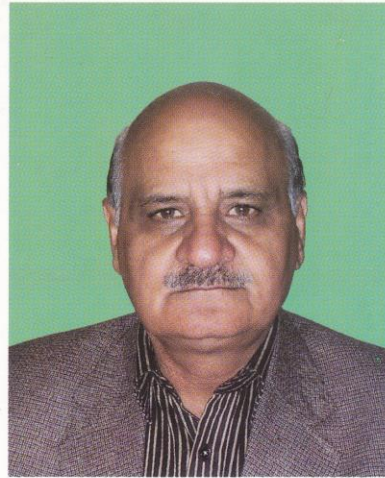

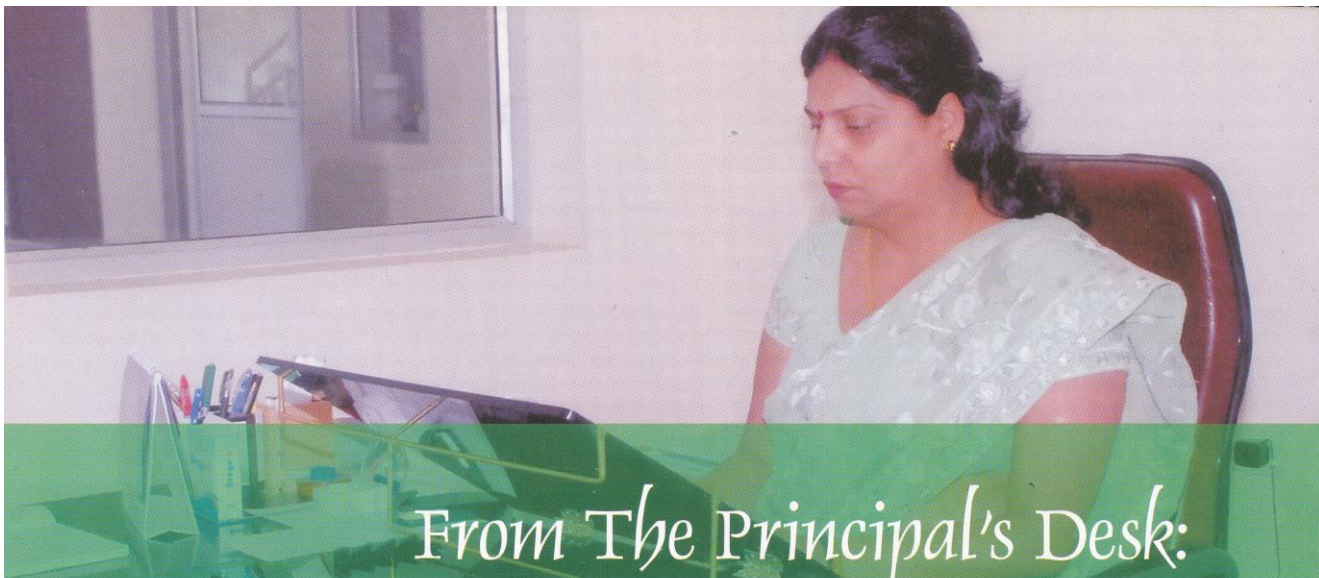
With this new team and my experience of Don Bosco Public School, we assure you of an education with a holistic and modern approach of learning.

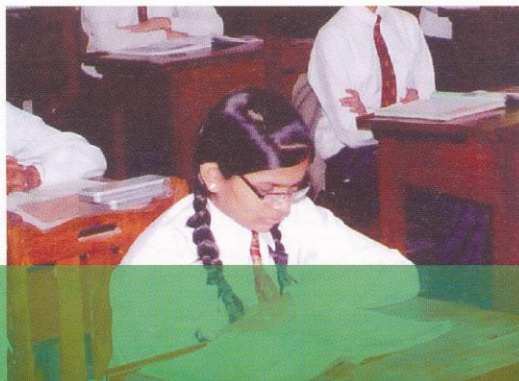


Aims And Objectives

CCE refers to periodicity and regularity in assessments and discourages mechanical testing, reduces the stress on a student. CCE helps in improving student's performance both in scholastic and co-scholastic areas right from the beginning of academic session. As a part of CBSE curriculums, the school undergoes CCE from class VI to X as per Board's instructions.

The students will have only TWO TERMS and a grading system at the end of the session. Grade points are directed by the Board.

Please do remember the school can not issue any certificate in Class X as it comes from the Board (consisting of Grades for both Class 9 and Class 10).

Educational Tour:

Computer Education:

Computer Education, keeping pace with the latest trends in Information & Technology is provided compulsorily to all the students. Well equipped computer labs with latest machines and softwares are the most frequented resource houses and attraction of the school. Computer education system had been evolved to intensify the process of learning through multi-way communication and interaction





The school has classes from II – XII and prepare students for the All India Senior Secondary Examination of CBSE, Delhi. The medium of instruction is English.

Scheme Of Studies

Academic Year :

The academic year begins in March and finishes in December, it is divided into two terms.

- March to June
- July to December (1st Week)

The annual examination for classes II – X are held in the month of December whereas the examinations for Class XI is held in February and XII is conducted by the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education). It takes place in the month of March. The school has a short monsoon break of about 2 weeks in June and long winter vacations for the months of December, January and February.

Admissions:

Depending upon vacancies, admission from classes II –IX for the session commencing from March, is granted on the basis of an admission test-cum- interview, in January and February. No admission is made to class X and XII. Guardians are required to get the names of their wards registered in advance by filling in the registration form & paying the registration fees, as per the stipulations in the registration form. The school does not accept any donation for admissions.

All new entrants shall have to produce transfer certificate from the school last attended within a period of 15 days of their joining the school. They are also required to produce a medical certificate to the effect that they are free from all contagious and infectious diseases and are otherwise physically fit enough to be admitted to a residential school. A student would be sent home if found medically unfit later or is unable to take part in games and other co-curricular activities. The parents have to give a written undertaking to this effect. The admission of student is valid upto class X.

Promotions:

Promotion to the higher class is done at the end of the annual examination. According to the promotion policy, finalized by the examination committee.

Normally a girl is required to secure 33 in each subject and 40% in the aggregate in the lower classes. For classes IX and X the referred limits is of 40% and 60% respectively.

Medical Facilities:

The institution has a small dispensary. In serious cases, students are sent to Haldwani. The school does its best to provide the required medical aid but does not owe any responsibility for accidents or mishaps beyond control.



Rules And Regulations



Food and Messing:

There is a common dining hall where veg & non-veg well balanced food is provided. The food is wholesome and nutritious.

Correspondence:

All the correspondence hence forth to be done through net only. Hence parents should submit their valid e-mail ids. Parents can go through their ward's performance, etc through the net whose website address is mentioned on the cover page along with our e-mail id.

Valuables:

Guardians are advised not to give valuable articles like costly watches, cameras etc. to their wards when they come to the school. The school does not take any responsibility for the loss of such valuables.

Note : No cell phone, ipods, memory chips etc are not allowed in the school. If found it will be confiscated.

Phone calls:

Phone calls are allowed daily from Monday to Sunday between 4.00pm to 5.00 pm.

Visiting:

Parents please strictly refer to the fixture given to you.





Rules And Regulations

Attendance:

Children who appear for Board examination must have full attendance. Children with short attendance will not be allowed to appear for the board examination of classes IX, X, XI and XII.

Fees and Payments:

The school fees is to be paid in two equal installments 1st during the time of admission and 2nd in the 1st week of August. If the installment of school fees are not paid within due time, a penalty of Rs. 100 per day is levied. Payment should be made to the school by Pay Order / Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'Don Bosco Girls College' payable at Haldwani.

Withdrawals:

Guardians who wish to withdraw their wards at the end of a term have to give two months notice preceding the commencement of the next term, failing which they have to pay the full fee. Students withdrawn during the middle of the year will be required to pay the fee of whole year. In case of new admission fees once paid will not be refunded. A transfer certificate is issued only after all dues have been cleared.

Winter Study Camp:

Since following winter vacation, Board Exams commence almost immediately, a winter study camp is run in the school for Board classes. Charges for this study camp are not included in the routine fee schedule.

Leave Rules:

Ordinarily, no leave is granted during the term. Leave for religious functions and marriages should be avoided to the utmost possible extent. In case of the marriage of real brothers and sisters or parent's brothers and sisters, leave may be granted if applied for in advance, accompanied by the printed invitation card. No leave is granted during examination.

If a student remains absent without information for a week after vacations his name will be struck off the rolls. Students should come back to school on the date given after the holidays.
