Historical Sketch

The promoters of the school are the family members of Shri Ramji Lal Yadav. The family is no novice in the field of promoting education in rural and backward areas. Their first venture was a co-educational school in District Jhunjhunu in Rajasthan in 1958. At that time it was the only school in the entire Narnaul Khetri area. The aim was to make education available in an area where most children did not go to school. The main thrust was to encourage parents to send their girl child to school, almost all of whom grew up without the benefit of a school education.

Towards the fulfillment of their laudable commitment to social and cultural causes the family members have set up a new school.

The Rajasthan School Kotputli, is in a comparatively progressive area of Rajasthan. The aim is to provide quality education in an area where education is still considered to be a mere mastery of few. Realizing the paramount importance of quality education, the school has been eventually made to blossom into a full-fledged co-educational complex by the illustrious luminaries and the sons of the soil.



Geographical Location

Kotputli is a rapidly growing a quaint Rajasthani town in Kotputli-Behror. The Rajasthan School is situated amidst scenic surroundings on the Jaipur-Delhi Road, away from the distractions and unwholesome effects of modern city life. In the serene surrounding of rural Rajasthan a peaceful and attractive campus has been developed to ideally suit the academic pursuits.

Our School

The main school building is an imposing edifice with elegantly designed classrooms and well equipped laboratories. The spacious and attractive library follows an open shelf system. An adequately equipped computer centre is a special feature worth mentioning. The art room and the music room are added attractions.

The school has very spacious & well furnished boarding houses with Air Conditioners , a modern kitchen, dining hall and a common room.

The spacious play grounds, the basket-ball court, football, volleyball court, cricket field, badminton and kho-kho court, facilities for yoga, table-tennis and other indoor games, all blended together with a lush green beautiful stadium is what one gets in this campus.

School Terms

Academic session is from April to March. The first term is from April to September and the second term from October to March.

School has three long vacations when the boarders are permitted to go home.



The Campus



The School is a Senior Secondary Co-educational English Medium affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, Bharat The centre is fully equipped with ultra-modern educational facilities. All type of co-curricular activities along with sports and games facilities are provided to develop the wholesome personality of the students

The School is a self-sufficient campus of over 13 acre land. The campus buildings are designed by renowned architects. A good part of the school campus is the left open area for students to play and take a part in cultural activities. The airy, sunny and spacious campus provides ample breathing space for the students.



Co-curricular Activities

Another way in which the school seeks to develop individual talent is through participation in co-curricular activities. The school offers a plethora of opportunities through clubs, hobbies, societies, various workshops and activities. Regular career counseling and workshops help the students to chalk out their future with a clear understanding of the profession which they may opt to choose. Leadership skills are developed through the student's prefectural committee and students are trained to take responsibility for their own.



NCC Training

This training is engaged in grooming the youth of the country into discipline and patriotic citizens.



Games & Sports

The scheme of physical education is so planned as to ensure the fullest and manifold development of the individuality of the child, enabling him to attain mental soundness, emotional stability and physical maturity.

Games and sports are organized in such a way as to ensure participation by all students at the same time. Students take part in the following games: Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Cricket, Lawn Tennis and Badminton according to the season and indoor games like Table Tennis, and Chess etc. Besides the Inter-House competition, school teams participate in Inter-School matches. In addition to games the school lays great stress on athletics and Taekwondo.

Field and track events are organized every year.

A number of students have represented the school at National Level, State Level and Distt Level Games.



Library



A well stocked and well equipped school library is a frequent haunt of book lovers among the students. The school library has a very rich stock of books, dictionaries, magazines, journals and a wide collection of audio–video cassettes and CDs offering intellectual food to both the teachers and students. The school organizes book fairs to help the students develop their reading habits.

Computer Lab

The school has an updated computer lab with modern internet and Email facilities, which is an integral part of modern living. Parents can rest assured that their children are well taken care of as we look after each student individually. Our teachers are fully dedicated to carry out their responsibilities and take pains to ensure that each student is doing well in studies. The environment of the campus guarantees good mental and physical health of the students



Science Labs

Well designed and fully equipped Physics, Chemistry and Biology Lab have been setup in the school in accordance with the CBSE guidelines.





Teaching Technology

The school facilitates digital learning right from LKG to class XII. The use of this modern technology enables the students in concept clearing, analyzing, in depth understanding and retaining the knowledge for whole life. The school nurtures the talent of the students by project works and regular off the beat assignments.

Evaluation Process

The school has adopted the continuous evaluation system based on Periodic Tests and Terminal examinations. Promotions to the higher classes are granted on the basis of the total performance spread over the whole year and not on the basis of the final examination alone. Obviously, this is not applicable to senior Classes.





Mess & Meals

There is a big dining hall and a modern kitchen with latest kitchen equipment to cater for the needs of dining members.

Great care is taken in cooking and serving a well-balanced diet four times a day.

Boarders

Milk is served every day. Special diet is provided on medical advice. Housemasters and teachers take their meals with the students.



School Canteen

The School canteen meets the refreshment needs of the staff and students by providing softdrinks, snacks etc at reasonable prices.

Electricity & Water Supply

The School provides an abundant supply of hot and cold water and regular electric supply supplemented by our own high power generators in case of power failures. Besides our own RO water purification plant ensures pure, germ free drinking water.





Festivals

The school celebrates various religious festivals like Holi, Dussehra, Deepawali Gurunanak Jayanti, Janmashtmi, Basant Panchami, Eid, Christmas etc and National Festivals like Independence Day, Republic day etc. Talks and discussions by prominent local citizens and by members of the staff are organized on such occasions.



Boarding

Residential facilities are like a home away from home. The school has a spacious and well-furnished hostel with modern amenities. The aim is to provide comfort but not luxury. Air conditioned/cooled hostel facilities are available for the students coming from different parts of the country. Students are provided with spacious, well-furnished comfortable rooms in a quiet environment conducive to concentration and studies. The hostel is under the care of resident wardens and offers an excellent environment for living, learning and growing to one fullest potential. The senior students are given responsibilities such as prefects, captains and monitors. A well-furnished recreation room, study room, and visitors room are in the hostel. There are House Masters, Asst. House Masters and Matrons who are affectionate, fluent and well versed in etiquette and manners to look after children and provide them with homely atmosphere in the hostel.





Tours, Treks & Visits

All students from class I onwards go on educational tours. Even the students of Nursery group enjoy picnics during the session. The school encourages visits to places of educational, historical and cultural interest as part of their education.



Health Care & Medical Facility

The safety of the students is given special attention. Round the clock Security of the campus is maintained.

A fully equipped clinic and separate sick rooms for boys and girl are available. The students are medically checked at regular intervals and proper health records are maintained. The parents are informed only in case of the serious illness of the child.

Registration & Admission

Registration for admission is carried out on payment. Please note that registration of student does not automatically entitle the student for admission. Documents: required are as follows

- Date of Birth Certificate
- Transfer Certificate in Original generated through RTE Portal
- Attested Mark sheet of the qualifying examination along with the original.
- A medical certificate from a recognized Doctor.
- 02 passport size photos.
- One passport photo of father, mother and guardian of student
- Aadhar Card of both Parents.
- Aadhar Card of student.

Admission to various classes from LKG to IX and XI is open to all on merit basis and subject to availability of seats. Admissions are made every year on the basis of entrance test in various subjects. The Principal's decision in this regard will be final and binding in all respects. Entrance Tests are conducted in the school. Admission is only granted on submitting the mark-sheet as proof of his/her having passed the previous class. The provisional admission is only confirmed when a school leaving certificate from the school last attended is submitted. In case, certificate is not submitted, the scholar's name will be struck off from the school rolls.

If a student clears the admission test and interview, the parent is required to deposit the school fees for the first term immediately, failing which the selection would be treated as cancelled.

Fees Policy

- a. For details of fees, please see the schedule given separately with the prospectus.
- b. The amount deposited towards application form for a particular year will neither be refunded nor transferred to any particular year or in account of any siblings.
- c. The Management reserves the right to revise the fees structure yearly at the beginning of the academic year.
- d. No remission of fees is allowed on account of long absence.
- e. If fee is not paid on or before the specified date, late fee of Rs.10/- will be charged per day for first fifteen days, Rs 20/-for next fifteen days and after one month the name will be struck off from the rolls and it will be considered as new admission. After 01 month 50 % of admission fees along with the pending dues and penalty as specified will be applicable.

Mode of payment

- a. Fees must be deposited in 04 installments between 01 to 10 April, 01 to 10 July, 01 to 10 Oct and 01 to 10 Jan every year.
- b. Fees may be deposited by Cheque in favour of 'The Rajasthan School, Kotputli, but in case of dishonor of cheque, 5 % of total amount of cheque with bank charges will be imposed as a penalty, again the same fees including penalty charges will be accepted through cash only.
- c. Fees and other dues can also be deposited directly online in school account on the details as given below

- d. Fees can also be paid through various UPI apps such as Google Pay , Phone Pay, Paytm etc through scan code given below.

Withdrawals

- a. If a student is to be withdrawn after the Annual examinations in March, the intimation must be submitted to the school under receipt by 15 Feb , otherwise fees will become payable for 01 quarter fees of the next session.
- b. A nominal amount is to be deposited for Transfer Certificate.
- c. If a student who has joined school in April, seeks withdrawal within 02 to 03 months, the fees will become payable upto Dec to partially compensates the school for loss due to the seat remaining vacant for the whole of the academic year.
- d. If a student attends the school for 01 or more than a week and leaves the school, fees deposited will not be refunded. One full quarter fees along with all admission fees will be charged.
- e. The student leaving the school without information / permission will be liable to pay full charges of 01 year.

School Rules

1. Parents/ Guardians will be bound by the school rules in all respects which may be changed from time to time. In all matters of dispute, the decision of the Principal will be binding on the Parents/ Guardians.
2. In accordance with the rules of the school, the Parents / Guardians will accept and authorize participation of their wards in compulsory programmes of tours, treks, camps, sports and cultural functions etc. during their stay at the school.
3. The Parents /Guardians will hold the school indemnified against all claims arising through illness, accident or any other cause.
4. The Parents/Guardians will authorize the Principal and through him/her the staff of the school to act as local parent of their wards while they are in the school or on tours, treks, camps etc.
5. The Parents /Guardians will authorize the Principal to take necessary action on their behalf in case of any emergency operation or any other such conditions where their permission is needed but cannot be obtained in time.
6. The Parents/Guardians will agree that in the event of their child / children being withdrawn during the course of the year, whatever the reason, the full fee laid down by the school for the whole year will be paid by them.
7. Smoking, use of tobacco in any form, use of alcoholic drinks or drugs, leaving school or station without permission are strictly prohibited. Students involving in any such or similar activities will be expelled from the school.
8. Use of mobile phones / smart watches is strictly prohibited in school. It will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the academic session.
9. The Principal is fully empowered to remove a student from school and hostel if in his/her opinion the student has failed to accept the discipline of the school and his / her continued presence is detrimental to the interest of the other students of the school and/or the student fails to come up to the academic standard of his/ her class and when detention in the same class would make the student too old for his/ her class.
10. All Parents will sign an agreement with the school at the time when their ward joins the school.
11. We believe in discipline with firmness. A student may be suspended / expelled / rusticated if he/she is found to be guilty of misconduct, insubordination, disobedience, theft, fraud, damage to or loss of school's goods or property, absence without leave for more than 10 days, habitual late attendance etc. smoking, conviction in any court of law for any criminal offence involving moral turpitude, giving false information, threatening, abusing or assaulting any school employee or student, abetment of or attempt at abetment of any of the above, failure or refusal to wear school uniform, any action which adversely affects the good governance of the institution.

Hostel Rules

- a. Food parcels from parents are not encouraged. In case they are sent, the contents of parcels are shared by the inmates of the Hostel.
- b. Students are not allowed to keep cash with them. No money is to be given to them and no money should be sent directly to the students. Any unauthorized money found with the student may be confiscated and credited to the personal A/c of the students. Students will be given pocket money from their personal accounts as per school rules. Borrowing or lending money and other personal belongings from each other is strictly prohibited.
- c. Students must not be given ipod, camera, mobile or other expensive articles to be brought to the hostel. School will not entertain any complain against any damage or loss of such articles.
- d. For ordinary ailments parents are not informed. If a student is admitted to the hospital, a communication is sent to the guardians.
- e. All correspondence by parents/ guardians regarding the student, should be addressed to the House Master of Boarding Hostel
- f. Parents and guardians are not expected to meet their wards direct in their Hostels. They should meet them through their House masters. The parents and guardians are also requested not to visit their wards too often.
- g. Ragging in any form is totally prohibited. Harassment, stealing, teasing or any form of ill treatment inflicted on juniors or other students will constitute a serious offence and may result in the expulsion of the offender from the school.

Leave Rules:

Students normally are not permitted to go on leave in the middle of the term except in very urgent cases as given below:

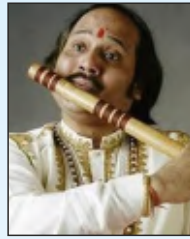
- a. Students may be permitted to a maximum of 3days leave if there is any important function or emergency in the family. Leave of this kind shall not be granted during examination days.
- b. Leave may be granted for special medical treatment provided the same is supported with medical documents.
- c. For leave, there should be a written request from the parent. Neither a request by the student nor any telephonic request from the parent shall be entertained. It is the responsibility of the parents to see that boarders are brought back on the scheduled date, failing which the school reserves the option to allow the child to be taken back or not.
- d. Boarders who have gone out due to some disease will have to produce the medical fitness certificate before they are taken back.
- e. Parents will have to make their own arrangement for their wards to travel to and from the school at the beginning and end of the each vacation. No student will be allowed to leave the school unescorted.
