We at Tula's have 24x7 medical facilities in the school campus. The school Infirmary is fully equipped to provide medical support to the students and staff members. The school infirmary has full time doctor along with nursing officers. Students at any point of time can come to the Infirmary along with their house parents. In case of emergencies school has 24x7 ambulance facility and have a tie ups with super speciality hospitals in Dehradun.

Student Counsellor

The psychologist meets the students as per referrals, evaluates them on the basis of their behavioural observations, presenting complaints, academic performances, and family dynamics and tries to determine whether they are going through any major psychological issue or it's a temporary behavioural manifestation precipitated by some external stimuli. Depending on the Initial assessment, the student is further referred for detailed psychometric evaluation or psychiatric consultation from any Government Institute or Hospital/qualified Psychiatrist (as per need) so that further certification processes can be taken care of as per CBSE guidelines.

Apart from that, a much more generalized approach is practiced by the school psychologist to have a knowledge of each student keeping in mind the basic fact that the children are passing through the formative years of their life. And during each day, they go through many experiences, some pleasant, some unpleasant and they need to open up about their emotionality to someone they can trust completely. Each and every aspect of school - as well as personal life and how it is being interpreted by the individual has a bearing on the students' psyche, be it friends, parents, teachers, anything and anyone. The Psychologist thus carefully builds up a rapport with the students and help them tide over any crisis in life so that they all can grow up to be mentally and physically healthy, joyful and dependable individual.
